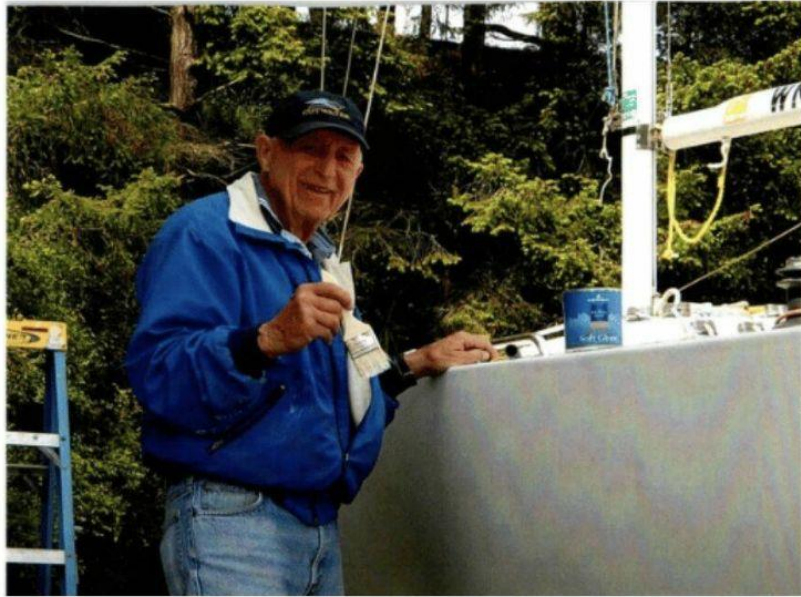

Born in Lyngby, Denmark, Arne knew he wanted to build boats & did his 8 years of training with 4 years apprenticeship in Denmark; gave 3 years of service to the Danish Navy; and immigrated to Canada in the 1950's. With his brothers, he owned & operated two shipyards and marinas until 1985 when he and his family moved to San Juan Island. Arne became a SAMS Accredited Marine Surveyor and served as harbor master to Shipyard Cove Marina until 2019. He is survived by his wife, Judy, his four children Erik, Leisl, Inge, Kirsten and grandchildren Karina, Blake, Calum, Connor & Dane, in addition to family in Denmark.
