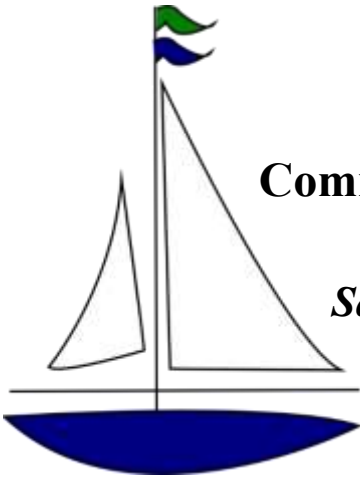

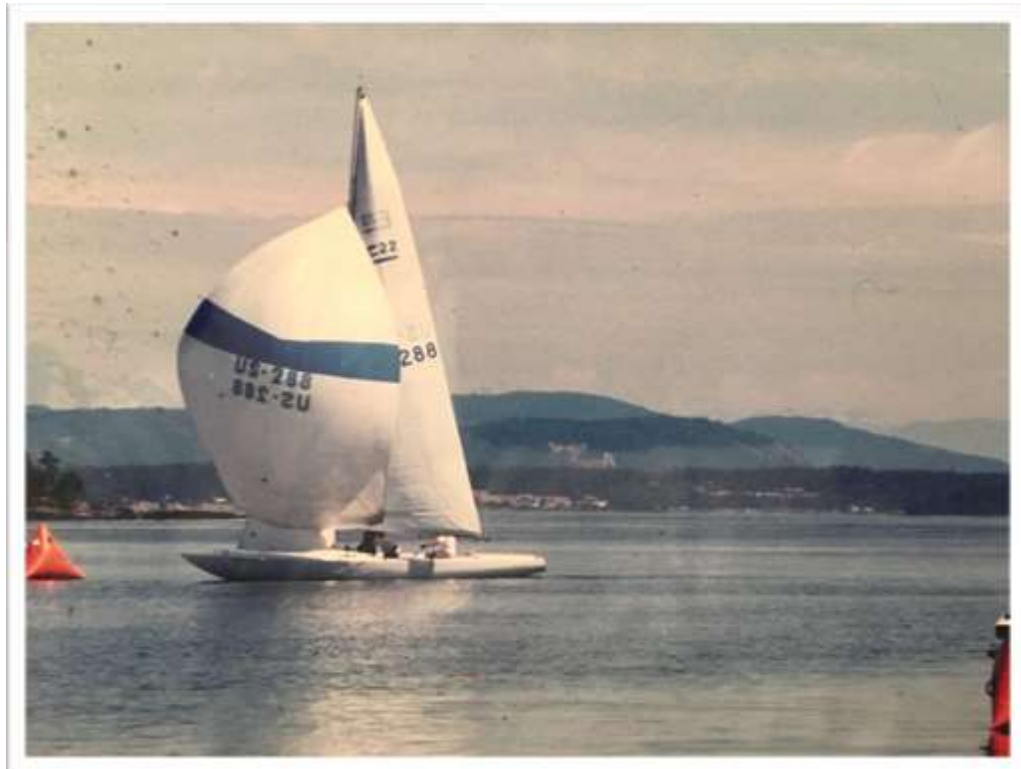

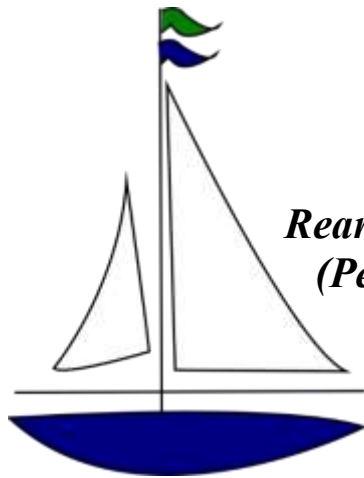
On March 13th , we distributed our 2021 roster from the Friday Harbor Grange. Many of us also received t-shirts designed by Ruth Ann Krooswyk.
